

- Majors
- Extra-Curricular / Co-Curricular Offerings

- Ask questions!

#### **Great questions to ask**

- How accessible are teachers outside of the classroom?
- What is the culture of the campus?
- What is the one event all students go to on campus?
- What is the campus like on the weekend?
- How's the food or what's your go to order on campus? What should I avoid?
- Describe the support/advisement/tutoring services available
- What was the hardest adjustment to make?
- If you could change one thing about your experience, what would it be?
- What is the number one complaint you hear most of the other students make about the school?
- What has been your most memorable moment or favorite tradition so far on campus?



## What colleges look for in the application process

- GPA/High School Transcript
- Standardized Testing (SAT/ACT)
- Interaction Quotient / Demonstrated Interest
- Interview
- Recommendations
- Essay
- Extracurricular Involvement
- Communication Flow (Phone Calls, Emails, Social Networks)
- Attention to details on application
